INTRO (Riff from 10th fret on E string)

10 10 9 9 8 8 7 7 6 6 5 5 4 3 2 1 [D Island x 4]

VERSE 1

[D] You keep saying you've got something for me.

Something you call love but confess [D7]

[G] You've been messin' where you shouldn't have been a messin'.

And now [D] someone else is getting' all your best.

CHORUS

These [F] boots are made for [D] walking, and [F] that's just what they'll [D] do.

[F] One of these days these [Dstop] boots are gonna walk all over you.

(Riff: end of D Island x 4)

VERSE 2

[D] You keep lying when you oughta be truthin'

And you keep losin' when you oughta not [D7] bet.

[G] You keep samein' when you oughta be-a-changin'.

Now what's [D7] right is right but you ain't been right yet.

CHORUS (end on D Island x 4)

VERSE 3

[D] You keep playin' where you shouldn't be playin'

And you keep thinkin' that you'll never get [D7] burned. (HA!)

[G] I just found me a brand new box of matches. (YEAH!)

And [D7] what he knows you ain't had time to learn.

CHORUS (end on D Island x 2)

[D] Are you ready boots, start walkin'...

Da-dum, ba-da-da, Da-dum, ba-da-da... Da-dum, ba-da-da-dum finish on 6.

OUTRO: (Riff – slow down and end vibrato on D chord)
